EXTENSION OF DECLARATION OF THE CITY OF POTEET, TEXAS, DECLARING A LOCAL STATE OF DISASTER AND PUBLIC HEALTH EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the City of Poteet on the 1st day of September, 2020, has determined that there is an imminent threat of injury or loss of life or property resulting from:

The novel coronavirus (COVID-19) has been recognized globally as a contagious respiratory virus and there has been an increase in cases that have been confirmed in Atascosa County, Texas and in Texas, and cases are expected to increase.

WHEREAS, the City Council of Poteet has determined that extraordinary measures must be taken to alleviate and prevent the suffering of people and to protect property; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT PROCLAIMED, BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF POTEET:

That a local state of disaster is hereby declared for Poteet pursuant to Section 418.108(a) of the Texas Government Code.

Pursuant to Section 418.108(b) of the Texas Government Code, the state of disaster shall continue for a period of not more than seven days from the date of this declaration unless continued or renewed by the City Council of the City of Poteet.


Pursuant to Section 418.108(d) of the Texas Government Code, this declaration of a local state of disaster shall be given prompt and general publicity and shall be filed promptly with the City Secretary.

Pursuant to Section 418.108(d) of the Texas Government Code, this declaration of a local state of disaster activates the city emergency management plan.

This shall extend the Amendment and Extension of the August 4, 2020 Local State of Disaster Declaration and Public Health Emergency issued by the City Council of the City of Poteet.

That this proclamation shall take effect immediately from and after its approval by the City Council of the City of Poteet and shall remain in effect for the next 30 days, unless revoked or extended by City Council of the City of Poteet.
